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➤ Information on Imereti Region and Kutaisi

Kutaisi Campus

City and Municipality

Imereti is one of the historical-geographical parts of western Georgia; its main city is Kutaisi. Imereti is divided into Upper and Lower Imereti. It is bordered on the north by the Likha Range, on the west by the Tskhenistskali River, on the east by the Caucasus Mountains, and on the south by the Fersati or Meskheta Mountains. The lowland landscapes of Imereti are covered with Colchian vegetation. Imereti has rich flora and fauna.

Imereti Lowland, the eastern part of the Kolkheti Lowland, has a subtropical climate. Winters are mild and warm, while summers are hot. The region experiences an average annual temperature between 11 and 15 degrees Celsius. Annual precipitation ranges from 800 to 1300 mm. In Upper Imereti, the climate is humid subtropical, with winters that are both early and rainy.

Imereti is a region with an ancient culture. It is also beautiful and diverse in nature. Remains of ancient Colchis, temples, waterfalls, mystical Khvamli mountain, and numerous caves will take you on a journey into the magical world.

The city of Kutaisi is located in the Imereti region, on the banks of the river Rioni. Kutaisi is the administrative center of the Imereti region. It is one of the oldest cities in Georgia and is the fifth-oldest city in Europe. People have inhabited the city area since ancient times. The Colchian culture thrived here from the XV-XIII centuries BC. Written history records Kutaisi from the 3rd century BC, but ancient authors described it as the capital of the Colchis Kingdom (8th century BC). The city's old names include Aia, Kutaia, and Kutaisi. On the right bank of the river Rioni, there are traces of an extensive settlement. In the VI century, Kutaisi was the capital city of Egrisi. By the end of the VIII century, it was the capital of the United Kingdom of Egri and Abkhazia. In the 10th century, Kutaisi became the capital of the newly united Georgia.

In 1122, David the Builder transferred the royal throne to Tbilisi, although Kutaisi remained an important city, both culturally and historically. Today, Kutaisi is the second city in Georgia with developed infrastructure and culture. There are higher educational and vocational schools, museums, theaters, galleries, etc., in Kutaisi. The city also has restaurants, cafes, hotels, cinemas, and other important facilities where you can relax and have a good time. Kutaisi attracts many tourists with its abundance of historical and cultural monuments. Ukimerioni Fortress, Gelati, Bagrati Temple, as well as many other cultural and natural monuments, and the beauty of the city itself will surely make you fall in love with Kutaisi.

➤ Transportation Services (public transport, payment system, taxi)

Kutaisi

There are two main types of public transport in Kutaisi: Municipal buses (M3) and minibuses (M2).

The cost of M3 transport is 40 tetri, while that of M2 transport is 50 tetri.

Both categories of transport have different winter and summer schedules, namely, during the winter the M2 type of transport starts operating at 7:00 and ends at 22:00, and in the summer period, from 6:30 to 23:00.

Waiting time varies according to the hours, namely: 7:00 to 20:00 (6-8 minutes), 20:00 to 21:00 (10-15 minutes), and 21:00 to 23:00 (15-20 minutes).
