Article 1. General Provisions

1. The present Regulation governs the process of conferring academic titles by the Central University of Europe LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "University").
2. An academic title is a distinction conferred upon a scholar or public figure in recognition of exceptional merit, in accordance with the procedure established by the legislation of Georgia.

Article 2. Honorary Doctorate

- 2.1. The University is entitled to confer the title of Honorary Doctor upon a scholar or public figure.
- 2.2. The title of Honorary Doctor may be conferred upon:
 - 2.2.1. A scholar and/or public figure who is a citizen of Georgia or a foreign state;
 - 2.2.2. A professor, researcher, or practitioner of internationally recognized standing within their respective field;
 - 2.2.3. An individual who has made a significant contribution to the advancement of the internationalization of research and the educational process, as well as to the promotion of inter-institutional collaborative activities;
 - 2.2.4. A figure who has made a substantial contribution to the development of higher education and science in Georgia, and/or a field specialist in recognition of their professional distinction;
 - 2.2.5. An individual in recognition of exceptional services rendered to the University.
- 2.3. No remuneration shall be issued to persons holding the title of Honorary Doctor.

Article 3. Procedure for the Conferral of the Honorary Doctorate

- 3.1 The decision to confer the title of Honorary Doctor shall be made by the Governing Board of the University, on the basis of a duly substantiated nomination submitted by the President or the Rector of the University.
- 3.2. The administration of the nomination process shall be ensured by the Human Resources Management and Administration Service of the University.
- 3.3. Upon conferral of the title of Honorary Doctor, a diploma, medal, and academic gown shall be issued as attestation of the academic title; the form and content thereof shall be approved by the Rector of the University.
- 3.4. The personal data of the Honorary Doctor, as well as a copy of the diploma, shall be maintained in the records of the Human Resources Management and Administration Service of the University.
- 3.5. A "Gallery of Honorary Doctors of the University" shall be maintained on the University's official website, presenting the career achievements of each honoree alongside the corresponding decision regarding the conferral of the Honorary Doctorate.

Article 4. Final Provisions

- 4.1 The present Regulation shall be approved by the Governing Board of the University and shall enter into force on the basis of an order issued by the Rector of the University.
- 4.2 Amendments and additions to the present Regulation shall be introduced upon approval by the Governing Board of the University and by order of the Rector of the University.
